Gentlemen:

This is in reference to your application dated February 25, 1960, for authorization pursuant to 10 CFR 20, Section 20.103, "Concentrations in effluents to unrestricted areas," to discharge into unrestricted areas liquid effluents containing radioactive materials.

In order for us to have first hand knowledge to evaluate your application, Mr. Lester R. Rogers, of my staff, accompanied by two consultants to the AEC, Mr. C. W. Christenson of the Los Alamos Scientific Laboratory and Dr. Abraham Goldin of the Winchester Laboratory, together with representatives of the U. S. Public Health Service and the Utah State Health Department plan to visit your mill on August 9, 1960. The purpose of this visit is to review your present waste treatment procedures and to obtain information as a basis for evaluating the effect of the waste effluent from your mill on the environment.

The U. S. Public Health Service may wish to gather liquid effluent and river samples in conjunction with their studies on stream pollution.

It is my understanding that the AEC Grand Junction Operations Office has informed you of this visit. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 and Section 40.21 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10--Atomic Energy, Chapter 1, Part 40--Control of Source Material, you are hereby authorized, in the event that during the term of this license you become entitled (except for limitations on such right imposed by said Act or said Regulations) to take and remove ore from the claims listed in Schedule A attached to Amendment No. 1, dated June 29, 1959, to Source Material License No. P-1267 issued to Utex Exploration Company, to transfer raw source material from such claims of Utex Exploration Company to your plant at Moab, Utah for processing at said plant [under Contract No. AT(05-1)-266 with the Atomic Energy Commission].

Both { The issuance of this license shall not be construed as constituting any determination by the AEC with respect to the right of the licensee to conduct mining operations on or to enter onto the property ~~comprising the claims set forth in the attached Schedule A~~ *referred to herein.*

Neither this license nor any right under this license shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the provisions of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954.

This license is subject to the right of recapture or control reserved by Section 108 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, and to all of the other provisions of said Act, now or hereafter in effect, and to all valid rules and regulations of the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission.

This license shall expire December 31, 1966.
