Subject: RADIATION CONTROL

With reference to our conversation this morning in regard to the radiation control program, I will outline the manner in which we agreed we will attack the problem.

1. You are charged with the responsibility of putting the entire operation of the plant in such a condition that we will at all times meet the radiation specifications as set forth by the proposed A.E.C. regulations which will go into effect shortly.

2. You will take immediate, temporary measures to correct certain situations which will reduce radiation levels.

3. You will take other long-range steps in an orderly fashion where capital expenditures are necessary or to meet the schedule outlined in our reply to the Commission's order of July 13, 1959.

4. You will establish priorities on the necessary work and materials to the extent necessary to accomplish our objective in the shortest possible time within practical limits and/or to permit your meeting schedules on time as outlined in our reply to the Commission's order.

5. You will rearrange your organization in such a manner that B. B. Winn will be able to devote 100% of his time to the radiation problem until you are satisfied that the work load has been reduced to the extent that he can assume other duties.

6. You will provide Curly with the necessary assistants in order to effectuate the program as outlined above.

From time to time you will have questions of policy and procedures that will require our consultation, in which case do not hesitate to discuss them with me whenever necessary. I would appreciate your keeping me posted on your program at frequent intervals.
