Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the undersigned's letter dated May 22, 1959, as supplemented by my telegram dated June 2, 1959.

This is to advise you that the licenses requested with respect to Standard Uranium Corporation is necessary only until April 1, 1962, instead of December 31, 1966. In checking Uranium Reduction Company's records it has been found that under the present arrangement ore will be shipped from Standard only until April 1, 1962, hence the modification in the license to reflect April 1, 1962 instead of December 31, 1966.

Separate applications for this have this date been forwarded for (1) Col-U-Mex Uranium Corporation, which has an interest in the properties being mined by Standard, requesting a license to April 1, 1962, and (2) Radorock Resources, Inc., requesting a license until December 31, 1966, because they have an interest in the claims being mined by Hecla Mining Company and shipped to Uranium Reduction Company.
