Gentlemen:

Reference is made to source material "P"
license issued to:

1. Hidden Splendor Mining Company
2. Lisbon Uranium Corporation
3. Mountain Mesa Uranium Corporation
4. Homestake Mining Company
5. La Sal Mining & Development Company
6. Utex Exploration Company
7. Hecla Mining Company
8. Rodorock Resources, Inc.
9. Standard Uranium Corporation
10. Col-U-Mex Uranium Corporation

The above companies are the mining companies whose claims are set forth in Appendix "H" (Rodorock has interests in some of the claims listed in Appendix "H" as being owned by Hecla, as does Col-U-Mex have interest in certain claims listed as being owned by Standard), as the properties from which Uranium Reduction Company will receive ore under Modification No. 2, Supplemental Agreement to Contract No. AT(05-1)-266, providing, among other things, for the extension of the contract from April 1, 1962 to and including December 31, 1966.

In view of the existing arrangements under the aforementioned contracts, the undersigned, for and on behalf of the above-named companies, hereby makes application for an amendment and extension for each of the

respective licenses as follows:

a. The licenses be amended to cover all of the claims listed in Appendix "H" of the Supplemental Agreement to Contract AT(05-1)-266, for the respective companies.

b. The licenses not extending to refined source material as well as raw source material be amended. This is necessary because of the contractual arrangements between Uranium Reduction Company and each of the mining companies whereby Uranium Reduction will concentrate the ore and then purchase the concentrate for immediate resale to the Atomic Energy Commission. The following language is suggested:

"To transfer and deliver possession of and title to raw source material from the claims listed in Appendix "H" of Contract AT(05-1)-266, and to transfer and deliver possession of and title to refined source material to any person licensed by the Atomic Energy Commission within the limits of his license."

c. That each of the licenses be extended to and including December 31, 1966, so that the Uranium Reduction Company and, in turn, the Trustee of the prime contract, is assured of a source of raw material until the expiration of said contract.
