Transmitted herewith is a report of an inspection of the subject licensed
facility.

As a result of the inspection the licensee was issued a Form AEC-592.
In paragraph 34 of the report and in the two memos attached to the report,
discrepancies which exist between the licensee's and AEC's analyses
results of duplicate liquid samples are discussed. These discrepancies
are the direct result of a difference in analytical procedures which are
employed by the licensee and AEC. We recommend that a definition of
"soluble" be obtained; if the definition agrees with the licensee's definition
we will ask the Analysis Branch, H&S, ID, to alter their techniques; but,
if the definition agrees with our definition, we recommend that DML so
inform the licensee at the time of their next license renewal.
