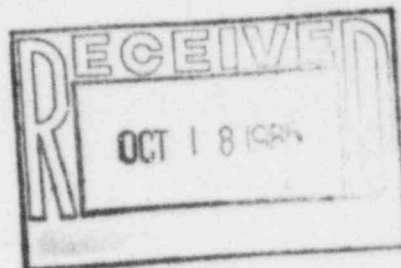

Dear Mr. Everett:

Uniroyal, Inc. is undergoing a corporate restructuring wherein assets currently owned by Uniroyal, Inc. will be transferred to various wholly owned subsidiaries. Uniroyal, Inc. will basically continue as a parent holding company for these subsidiaries. In the restructuring, Uniroyal, Inc.'s interest in the Ardmore facility will be transferred to Uniroyal Tire Company, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Uniroyal, Inc.

The Uniroyal Ardmore, Oklahoma Plant was issued Radioactive Material License 35-16911-01 by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for a nuclear gauge on January 21, 1980 with expiration date of May 31, 1986. Pursuant to Uniroyal's corporate reorganization, this license will need to be amended to reflect the new subsidiary's name, Uniroyal Tire Company, Inc. Uniroyal also has facilities in Naugatuck, Connecticut (Region 1), Stoughton, Wisconsin (Region 3) and Port Clinton, Ohio


(Region 3) that possess radioactive materials licenses and these regions have been notified of the corporate reorganization and transfer requirements for those licenses.

Uniroyal wishes to stress that no other aspect under this license will be changed as a result of the corporate reorganization; all operations and processes will remain the same. Only the name of the license holder of record must be amended to conform with Uniroyal's corporate reorganization. Uniroyal expects to complete the transfer of the assets to Uniroyal Tire Company, Inc. on or about October 27, 1985, although we are unable to give a firm date at this time. Consequently, Uniroyal requests that the permit transfer requested be effective as of completion of the asset transfer, rather than any specific date.
