2. SUA-616, Kerr-McGee Corporation, Grants, New Mexico. License expires November 30, 1966, but renewal is expected. Mill expected to continue operations through 1970. *40-1917*
3. R-161, Atlas Minerals Corporation, Moab, Utah. License expires December 31, 1966, but renewal is expected. Mill expected to continue operations through 1970.
