Based on the statements in your application, the Commission finds that the transfer of these licenses to the Babcock & Wilcox Company is in accordance with the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 as amended, and will not be inimical to common defense and security or constitute an unreasonable risk to the health and safety of the public. Accordingly, Item 1 of License Nos. SNM-145, SNM-414, SMB-502, 37-04456-03, 37-04456-01 and 37-07031-01, shall be changed to read: The Babcock & Wilcox Company.
