On March 6, 1986, representatives of Texas Utilities Electric Company met with Mr. Blaine Murray of the NRC Region IV office in Arlington, Texas, to discuss qualification requirements for the RPM position. - Previous work experience that can be applied toward qualifying as the RPM.
