
Re: FOIA Request Concerning All Licensing For The Southwest Experimental Fast Oxide Reactor

Dear Custodian:

In an Initial Decision captioned In Re Application By General Electric Company And Southwest Atomic Energy Association For A Provisional Construction Permit For The Southwest Experimental Fast Oxide Reactor ("SEFOR"), DKT No. 5-231 (Sept. 10, 1965), the Atomic Energy Commission granted a provisional construction permit for the construction and operation of a twenty megawatt (thermal) plutonia-urania-fueled, fast-spectrum, sodium-cooled, experimental reactor to be located near Fayetteville, Arkansas. Please consider this letter as a Freedom of Information Act request for any and all licenses, transfer licenses, or grants of legal authority of any nature whatsoever by the Atomic Energy Commission and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission with respect to the Southwest Experimental Fast Oxide Reactor from its genesis to the present day.
