Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the application filed jointly by General Electric and Southwest Atomic Energy Associates for license to construct and operate the proposed Southwest Experimental Fast Oxide Reactor. No statement is included therein that the applicants have complied with the provisions of 10 CFR Part 2.102(b) by serving a copy of the application on the chief executive of the county in which the facility is to be located.
