
SUBJECT: RECEIPT OF INFORMATION CONCERNING ALLEGED
DISCRIMINATORY HIRING PRACTICE AT WATERFORD 3

REPORT NUMBER: Q4-82-023

1. On October 6, 1982, Mr. Jim Sylvester, Investigator, U.S. Department of Labor, New Orleans, La., telephonically advised Reporting Investigator that his office has received, on October 6, 1982, a discrimination complaint from [redacted] Sylvester related that [redacted] reports he was hired as a [redacted] Dallas, Texas, who is providing contract personnel to a subcontract firm at Waterford 3 site, Taft, La. Sylvester advised [redacted] complaint related that when he arrived at Waterford 3 to begin work on September 27, 1982, an unidentified [redacted] invoked a Waterford 3 site procedure, [redacted]
2. [redacted] was formerly [redacted] a subcontractor at Waterford 3 site, Taft, La. [redacted] filed discrimination complaints with the Department of Labor (DOL), and subsequent DOL investigations support his complaint in both instances. Each of these cases have been appealed to DOL Appeal Hearing Boards and decisions are pending.
3. Sylvester stated that an investigation of [redacted] current complaint would be initiated immediately, and that the results of that investigation would be transmitted to Dallas Field Office, OI, NRC.
