Gentlemen:

The Atomic Energy Commission has issued an order extending to April 30, 1969, the latest completion date specified in Construction Permit No. CPPR-17. The permit authorizes the General Electric Company and Southwest Atomic Energy Associates to construct a 20-megawatt thermal plutonia-urania-fueled, fast spectrum, sodium-cooled experimental reactor in Cove Creek Township, Washington County, Arkansas. This extension was granted in accordance with the General Electric Company's request dated January 14, 1969.
