Gentlemen:

The Atomic Energy Commission has issued Provisional Operating License No. DR-15 authorizing the General Electric Company and Southwest Atomic Energy Associates (SAEA), with General Electric acting for itself and for SAEA, to possess, use, and operate the Southwest Experimental Fast Oxide Reactor (SEFOR) located in Cove Creek Township, Washington County, Arkansas. The license authorizes operation of the reactor at power levels up to 1 megawatt thermal.
