General Electric hereby requests authority to receive, possess and use up to 10 millicurie quantities each of Krypton-85, Iodine-131, Barium-Lanthanum-140, Cesium-137, and Xenon-133 and 10 milligrams of Curium-244 for the purpose of instrument checking and calibration in connection with the operation of the SEFOR Facility as part of the license amendment that will permit operation of the reactor to a nominal power level of 20 MW(t).
