RELEASE OF MATERIAL ATTACHED TO THE ACRS SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT ON MIDLAND PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2

In response to your request of November 30, 1976, I have enclosed copies of the Committee's Supplemental Report on the Midland Plant dated November 18, 1976, and all material attached with the report originally dispatched by this office on November 18, 1976, for in camera review by the Board and parties to the Midland hearing.

The material, which was inadvertently incorporated in the original package while it was being assembled by the ACRS Staff, and subsequently removed, consists of:

1. One page from the portion of the minutes of the 106th ACRS meeting dealing with the Midland Plant Units 1 and 2.

This material has been released to NRC's Public Document Room as part of a general release of ACRS meeting minutes, and we would have no objection to its release to any party to the current hearing.

2. Three lists of background documents which had been provided to the Committee for information in connection with the ACRS reviews of Hutchinson Island Unit No. 1, the Palisades Plant, and Three Mile Island Unit No. 1.

These lists of background documents were added to the ACRS Office Copies of the project reports for the convenience of this office and were not included in the Reports sent to the Commission by the Committee. Documents referenced in the reports which were sent to the Commission are those portions of the applications provided for Committee review and evaluation in connection with the specific cases involved and are listed in the material attached to the Supplemental ACRS report on the Midland Plant dated November 18, 1976.


It is my understanding that, with the exception of the ACRS Consultant reports noted below, all of the listed background documents have been incorporated in the dockets for the specific cases involved and the bulk of this material is available in the NRC Public Document Room.
