

MATERIALS LICENSE

Amendment No. 48

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.



As mentioned in our letter dated August 5, 1996, Mail Control Number 123598, the separate Baltimore, Perry Point, and Fort Howard VA Medical Centers have been consolidated as the VA Maryland Health Care System (VAMHCS), which is under my direction. Each facility has retained its individual Materials License.

We would like to request an amendment to Materials License 19-07187-01, issued to the VA Maryland Health Care System, Perry Point Medical Center. The present Authorized User, and Chairman of the Radiation Safety Committee, R. V. C. Kamath, M.D., is leaving the Perry Point facility, and must be replaced on the license.
