

Cardiology Associates of Fairfield County, P.C. holds US Nuclear Regulatory Commission byproduct materials license 06-07795-01. We wish to amend our license to allow us to add another site to our current license. At this time, we are operating at 40 Cross Street, Norwalk, CT 06851. We wish to add a site at 1275 Summer Street, Stamford, CT 06905. We anticipate a need for operation at our new Facility on or about January 15, 1997. We have attached annotated drawings showing the location of our proposed areas of use of byproduct materials, including the Hot Lab and Scanning Room.

Please note that this license amendment and operation at this site is only for nuclear cardiology procedures involving materials identified in 10 CFR 35.100 and 10 CFR 35.200 excluding radioactive gases, to be used in a private practice facility. The applicant will not obtain a Tc99/99 Mo generator. There is no intent to purchase any materials in bulk form, and all pharmaceuticals will be obtained in unidose form from a licensed pharmacy.

Some radioactive wastes from the pharmacy (i.e. unused unidoses or syringes containing radioactivity) will be returned to the pharmacy for disposal. Records of this transfer will be maintained by the applicant. Other wastes such as used syringes, tubing, sponges, wipes, and other contaminated materials will be held by the applicant in storage for decay in storage. These materials may have an associated biohazard which makes them non-returnable to the radio pharmacy. The facility design will meet 10 CFR 20.1101 and 10 CFR 20.1301 requirements or more restrictive State regulatory limit, for exposure limits for the radiation worker and the general public.

The applicant will not be using radioactive gases or conducting any radionuclide therapy procedures.

If the needs of the Applicant/Physician require the operational scope to change, the license will be amended before the Applicant/Physician makes those changes.


We intend to use and have on hand, sealed sources for quality control and use with the dose calibrator. These include Barium 133, Cesium 137, and Cobalt 57 sealed source, each with a maximum activity of 15.00 mCi. In addition, a Cobalt 57 sealed source with a maximum mCi activity of 10.00. If the sources decay to levels below those stated 10 CFR 35.50 (B) (1) (2), they will be replaced.

Of course, we will continue to perform required area surveys each day of use and wipe surveys each week of use at this new location.

This site will operate within the requirements of our current license as stated in our most recent renewal submitted 2/15/95 and in accordance with the requirement of the CFR.





Facilities—Annotated Drawing of the Radioisotope Facility




