Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). 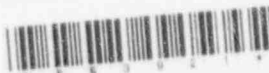

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Dear Sir or Madam:



We plan to relocate our office in Branford, CT to a new office building in Guilford, CT. The address is 1591 Boston Post Road, Guilford, CT 06437. Our plans are to have the nuclear cardiology section operational by the end of May. The Hot Lab and imaging room will be surveyed and wipe tested for removable contamination, and, decontaminated if needed, prior to release for unrestricted use. Those results will be forwarded to your office if you so desire.

Enclosed are diagrams of the agencies and of the room details. The nuclear cardiology operations will follow the model procedures that were identified in our license renewal application of 1995.

If you have any questions or desire additional information, please contact Mr. Peter J. Mas, M. S., our consulting physicist, or if need be, myself at (203) 495-6880.

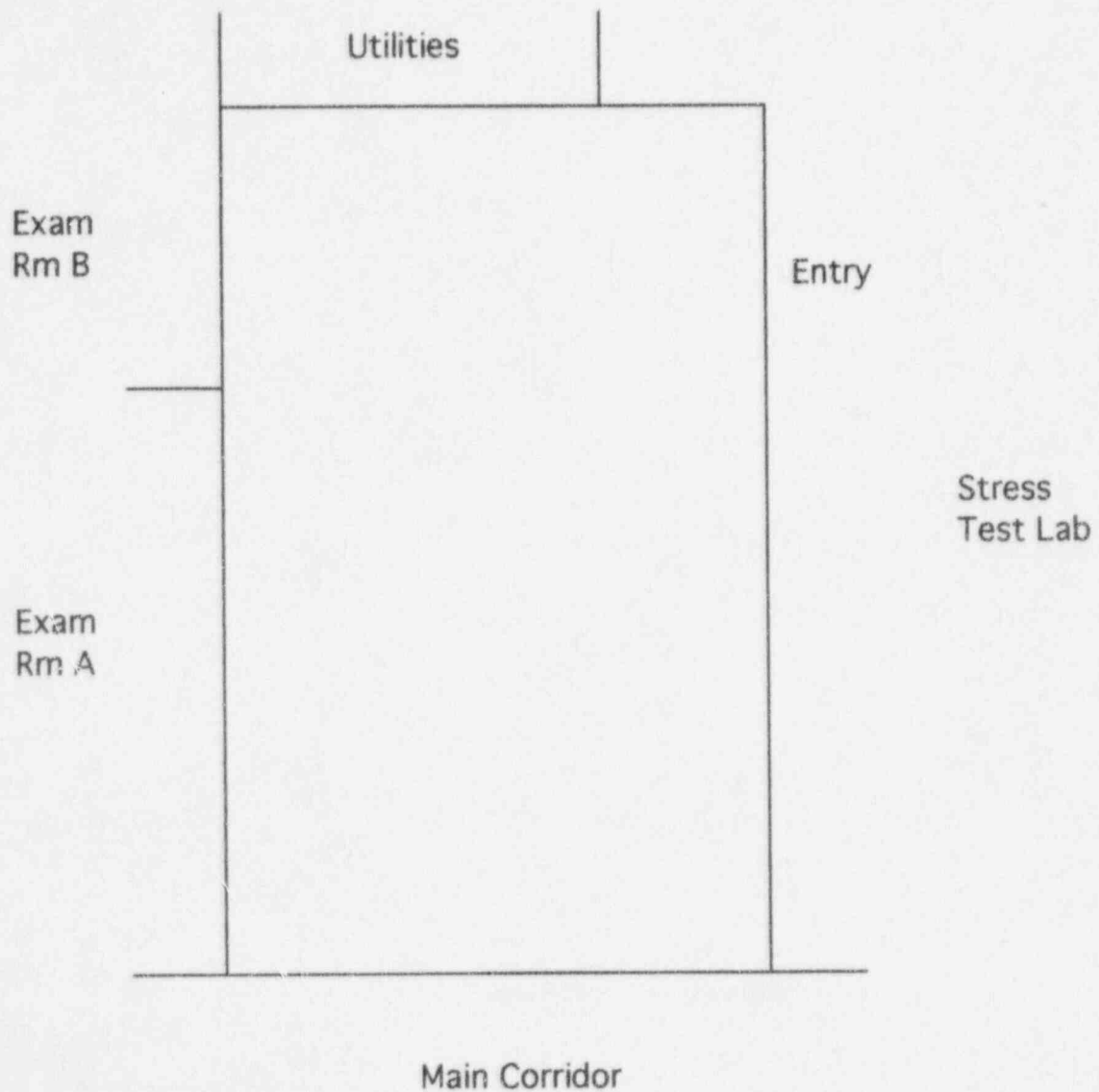

ADJACENCIES - GUILFORD

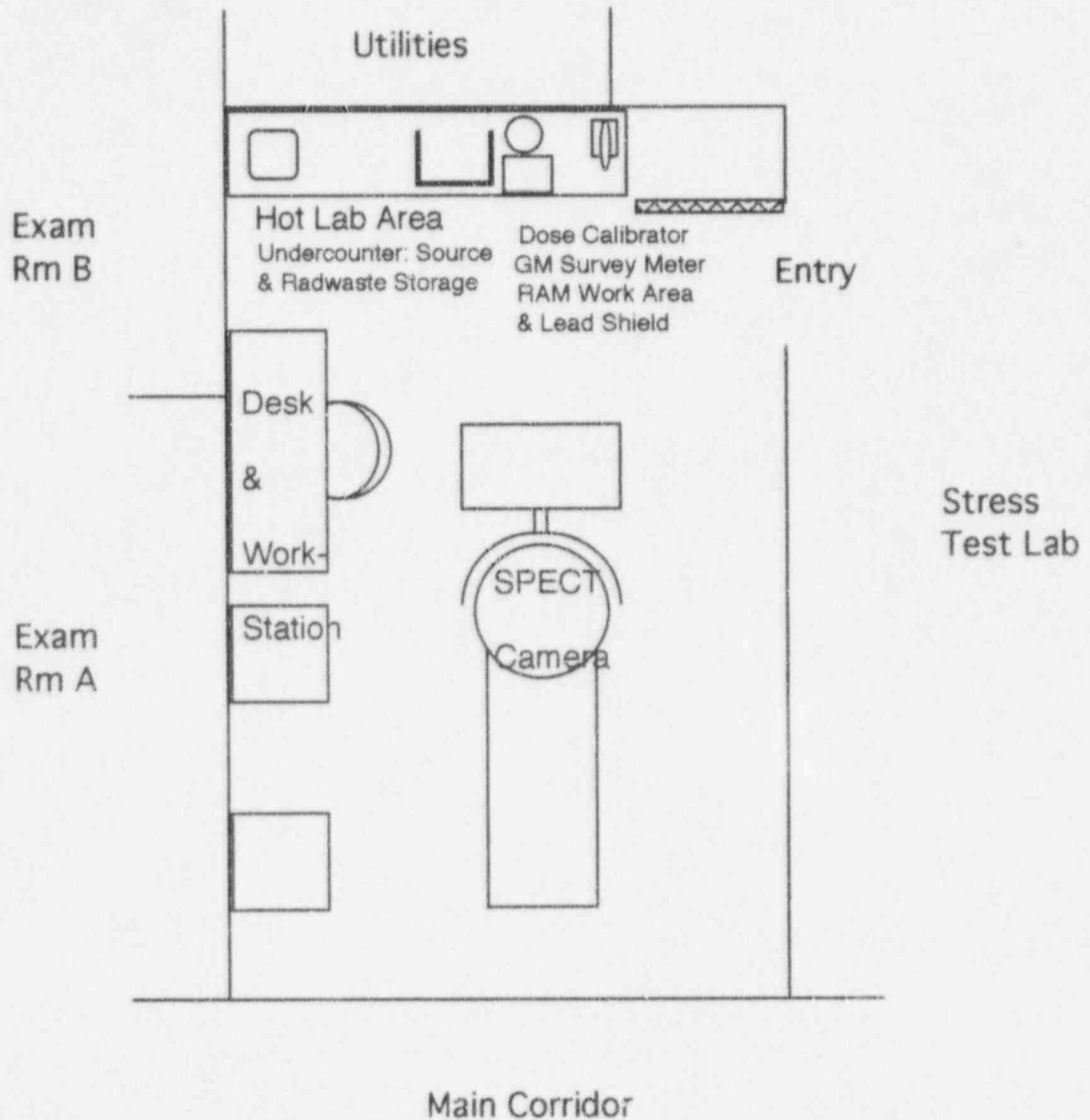
