ORDER EXTENDING PROVISIONAL OPERATING LICENSE EXPIRATION DATE

General Electric Company and Southwest Atomic Energy Associates having filed a request dated August 24, 1970, for an extension of the expiration date of Provisional Operating License No. DR-15 which authorizes the possession and operation of the Southwest Experimental Fast Oxide Reactor (SEFOR), a sodium-cooled experimental reactor, at thermal power levels not to exceed 20 megawatts located in Coves Creek Township, Washington County, Arkansas, and good cause having been shown in the application for this extension pursuant to 10 CFR, Section 50.57(d) of the Commission's regulations, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the expiration date of Provisional Operating License No. DR-15 is extended from September 4, 1970, to March 4, 1972.
