Enclosed is an application for renewal of our NRC license #36-19375-01. Because of an administrative error in receiving our notice, we were unable to submit this renewal 30 days prior to expiration. The notification of expiration was inadvertently sent to our Richland, Washington, office. We have corrected this problem by adding our routing code to the address on the renewal form. This should eliminate any confusion in the future.

There are three minor changes that are requested with this renewal.

(1) David L. Jackson has retired from BPA. I am his successor and will be the new applicant on this license. (2) Page 7 of the Standard Operating Procedure is changed to include James Sutton's current telephone numbers. (3) Bill Butler is no longer with our organization and his name was removed as alternate radiation safety officer.

The other aspects of our program, including management control, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, waste disposal procedure and radio-nuclides remain unchanged at this time. We anticipate some personnel change within the next year and will amend the license as necessary at that time.

A copy of our current license (which includes all necessary information for items 5-11 on the renewal form) and our up-to-date standard operating procedure is attached in duplicate as requested.
