The process embodied in the staff's RAI is related to recent staff work in developing Draft Regulatory Guide 1064 (which the license has not seen, because it has not been released for public comment). The license also agreed to provide some level of description of the categorization process in the QA program description.

Regarding followup activities, HL&P plans to respond to the RAI within the next few weeks. The staff plans to continue its review and evaluation of HL&P's graded QA application during a site visit in early May 1997.
