





Dear Mr. Loyd:

We have received your letter dated February 21, 1997, requesting the termination of your byproduct materials License No. SUC-1429. In order to terminate the license, the NRC must document specific information regarding the current and past radiological status of the facility and prior use of radioactive materials. Therefore, in order to continue our review of your termination request, we need that following additional information:

1. Complete the NRC Form 314 (attached). Please sign and date the form at the bottom.
2. 10 CFR 30.36(k) (4) states that specific licenses will be terminated when the Commission determines that records required by 10 CFR 30.51(d) and (f) have been received by the Commission. 10 CFR 30.51(d) does not pertain to your license. However, 10 CFR 30.51(f) states that prior to license termination, each licensee shall forward the records required by 30.35(g) to the appropriate NRC Regional Office. Therefore, transfer the required records to this office or provide a statement explaining why each of the records required is not applicable to your licensed program. A copy of Part 30 is attached for your convenience.
3. Attachment 1, entitled "Required Information for the Decommissioning and Termination of Licensed Facilities" contains guidance outlining the information that the NRC needs to complete a facility decommissioning review. Please provide the information requested in Items 1 through 12. If an item is not applicable, please so indicate and explain why it is not.

Review of your request will continue upon receipt of this information. Please reply in duplicate, within 15 days, and refer to Control Number 302400.
