Accordingly, conditions 6E, 7E, and 8E, and 10 are modified to read:

6E. Unirradiated uranium contaminated with plutonium-239 7E. UF₄ 8E. 4080 kg (9,000 lbs)

10. Authorized use: For use in accordance with the statements, representations, and conditions in Chapters 1 through 7 of the application dated July 11, 1994, and supplements dated September 6, October 3, and November 16, 1994; and March 1, April 6, and April 19, 1995; and September 6 and November 25, 1996, and March 17, 1997; and supplement letter dated February 27, 1995, April 2, and April 16, 1997.

All other conditions of the license shall remain the same.
