Dear Dr. Reda:

This is in response to your correspondence dated December 11, 1996, by which your facility submitted changes to Chapters 3.0, 4.0, and 6.0 of your Fundamental Nuclear Material Control (FNMC) Plan. We have completed our review of the submitted changes, and have determined that these changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the FNMC Plan, and thus were properly submitted under the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(c). Accordingly, the revisions to your FNMC Plan are acceptable, and Safeguards License Condition SG-1.1 of your Materials License SNM-1097 will be updated in a future license amendment to reflect the current changes.

We agree with your determination that the enclosures to the December 11, 1996, letter contain information of the type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d) which is deemed to be commercial or financial within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.17(a)(4). Accordingly, said enclosures will be withheld from public disclosure unless subject to the provisions of 10 CFR 9.23.
