Dear Mr. Norris:

The purpose of this letter is to provide the results of a radiation survey conducted at your facility on April 15, 1997. The location of the survey was the storage cabinet that formerly was used to store a nuclear density gauge.

The cabinet is approximately 8 feet tall, 4 feet wide, and 4 feet deep. A grid, two columns from side to side and three rows from top to bottom was used for selecting measurement points. Measurements were made near the front and back of the cabinet at each grid point for a total of 12 measurement points.

No readings above 0.05 millirem/hour (mrem/hr) were observed at any of the grid points.
