Condition 24. is amended to read:

24. Except as specifically provided otherwise in this license, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents including any enclosures, listed below. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.
- A. ALARA Program dated February 25, 1981 signed by J. Patrick Dyson, Executive Vice President submitted in regard to License Number 21-04177-01; and
- B. Letters dated November 7, 1983 (with enclosures) signed by William G. Van de Riet, Ph.D. and Joseph A. Wasserman, Executive Vice President, April 11, 1984 signed by Joseph A. Wasserman, Executive Vice President, and November 29, 1985.

Condition 25. is added:

25. Pursuant to Section 20.105(a) of 10 CFR Part 20, and in reliance on statements, procedures and representations made by the licensee in his letter dated November 29, 1985 the following maximum radiation levels are hereby authorized in the following unrestricted areas:
