Recently I learned that there is a plant (Kerr-McGee Corporation) located at Crescent, Oklahoma, for the manufacture of plutonium, or some form of it. Crescent is located within 20 miles of Oklahoma City, a city of 450,000 plus and the capital of Oklahoma. It is my understanding that this plant is operating on a temporary permit and has not passed the environmental quality control, also, that the handling of waste is not being satisfactorily taken care of.

The terrifying possibilities of a fire or escaping waste are so frightening I do not understand why the community has not been notified of the locating of this plant near Oklahoma City. I am very opposed to any nuclear plants being located in Oklahoma which is a very small state. Will you please advise what is being done about the permanent licensing of the plant at Crescent?
