Dear Mr. Johnson:

Reference is made to our teletype to you of July 7, 1970, and to your teletype reply dated July 9, 1970, concerning our submission and your review of details of design and operation of the new Sequoyah Waste Disposal System.

Attached hereto are two copies of a Kerr-McGee report entitled "Design Criteria for Chemical Waste Disposal" which, with its attachments, give the complete details on the system which we have installed and the method by which it will be operated.

The form of this submission is informational rather than regulatory with the thought that, since there is nothing novel in our approach and since discharge of radioactive material in the environs is held to a very small fraction of MPC, formal regulatory submission would not be necessary.
