Dear Governor Hall:

In order to be more responsive to the needs of the public, the Atomic Energy Commission is establishing throughout the United States locations where members of the public may inspect documents relating to applications for Atomic Energy Commission licenses to operate plants subject to its regulations. Locations are selected which are near the actual sites of proposed plants and are commonly in local libraries, thereby providing easy access.

In connection with two environmental reports presently before the Atomic Energy Commission's regulatory staff, i.e., "Applicant's Environmental Report - Uranium Hexafluoride Plant," and "Applicant's Environmental Report - Plutonium Fuel Plant," submitted by Kerr-McGee Corporation, copies of each application and subsequent correspondence, including environmental reports, will be furnished in the first case to Sallisaw City Library, 111 North Elm, Sallisaw, Oklahoma 74955, and in the latter case to the Carnegie Library, 402 East Oklahoma Street, Guthrie, Oklahoma 73044.

Copies of the environmental reports are also available for public inspection at the appropriate clearinghouses.

You may have occasion to refer members of the public who inquire of you concerning these cases to the above locations. As the Atomic Energy Commission's evaluation of each of these reports progresses, copies of pertinent documents will be forwarded to the appropriate library.
