W., Washington, D. C. and in the Sallisaw City Library, 111 North Elm, Sallisaw, Oklahoma. The Final Environmental Statement is also being made available at the State Clearinghouse, Office of Community Affairs & Planning, State Grant-in-Aid Clearinghouse, 4901 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 and the Metropolitan Clearinghouse, Arkoma Regional Planning Commission, 104 N. 16th Street, Fort Smith, Arkansas 72901. The notice of availability of the Draft Environmental Statement for the Sequoyah Hexafluoride Plant and requests for comments from interested persons was published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on April 18, 1974 (39 FR 13910). The comments received from Federal agencies, State and local officials and interested members of the public have been included as appendices to the Final Environmental Statement.


