


NEGATIVE DECLARATION
REGARDING RENEWAL OF LICENSE NO. SUB-1010
KERR-MCGEE NUCLEAR CORPORATION
URANIUM HEXAFLUORIDE FACILITY
SEQUOYAH COUNTY, OKLAHOMA
DOCKET 40-8027

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued a renewal of Source Material License No. SUB-1010 for the continued operation of the Kerr-McGee Nuclear Corporation Uranium Hexafluoride Facility, Sequoyah County, Oklahoma at the expanded production rate of 10,000 short tons per year of uranium as uranium hexafluoride.

The Commission's Division of Fuel Cycle and Material Safety has prepared an environmental impact appraisal for the renewal of License SUB-1010. On the basis of this appraisal, the Commission has concluded that an environmental impact statement for this particular license renewal is not warranted because there will be no significant increase in environmental impact attributable to the action over that evaluated previously (NUREG-75/007 dated February 1975). The environmental impact appraisal is available for public inspection and copying at the Commission's Public Document Room at 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.
