SUBJECT: EXPIRED LICENSE, WESTVACO CORPORATION

On January 10, 1986, a licensee representative, John J. Keller, Instrument Shop Foreman, was contacted and informed that License No. 37-19416-01 had expired on July 31, 1985 and that no renewal application had been received. The licensee representative explained that they have received and possessed licensed material, but now possess no licensed material and wish to have the license terminated.

Licensed material was disposed of by transfer to Texas Nuclear. This was confirmed in a letter from the licensee dated January 27, 1986 and by contact with William L. Hendrick. Project Engineer of Texas Nuclear License No. 6-3524, who confirmed that they had received two 20 millicurie Cs-137 sealed sources from the licensee on November 26, 1985 and that they are authorized to possess this material.

Based on a review of the information supplied by the licensee and a review of the type and form of material authorized by the license, a close out survey by the licensee is not required and this license may be retired.

Based on the above information, we have retired License No. 37-19416-01. Please remove it from your active shelves.


