Ford Nuclear Reactor in Support of the HSSI Program.


Dear Sir;

This letter is notification of our understanding of Docket 50-2, Operating License R-28 condition B.(4) with regard to possession and transfer of by-product material produced in the Ford Nuclear Reactor as a consequence of the Heavy Section Steel Irradiation Program. This understanding results from telephone conversations with NRR in Washington on June 4 and 5, 1997.

Our understanding is as follows:

1. The University of Michigan is licensed under Operating License R-28 to possess within the Facility (the Ford Nuclear Reactor and contiguous Phoenix Memorial Laboratory) such quantities of by-product materials as may be produced in experiments and fixtures irradiated in support of the Heavy Section Steel Irradiation Program; and
2. The University of Michigan is authorized to transfer these by-product materials from Operating License R-28 to other authorized recipients.
