Dear Mrs. Jackson:

This letter is to inform you that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has finished reviewing and deliberating on the April 24, 1997, request by Lucent Technologies, Incorporated (Lucent), to withhold certain information from NRC Inspection Report 99901309/96-01 in accordance with Section 2.790, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding," of Part 2, "Rules of Practice for Domestic Licensing Proceedings and Issuance of Orders," of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR Part 2.790). The staff has concluded that each item that Lucent requested to be withheld from public disclosure in the subject NRC Inspection report meets the threshold delineated in 10 CFR Part 2.790. A copy of the nonproprietary (public) version of the subject report is enclosed.

Additionally, thank you for your April 24, 1997, letter in response to the Notice of Nonconformance (NON) that was attached to the subject inspection report. We have reviewed your letter and find that your reply to the NON is responsive to our concern. We will review the implementation of your corrective actions during a future U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff inspection to determine that full compliance has been achieved and will be maintained. We have no further questions at this time and will review the corrective action and preventative measures which Lucent has taken during a future inspection.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room (PDR).
