
To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this letter as a request to transfer Nuclear Regulatory Commission General Licenses GL-723615-18 and GL-23793-23, which are held by Spring Creek Coal LLC and Antelope Coal LLC, respectively. This letter requests that those licenses be transferred to Navajo Transitional Energy Company, LLC ("NTEC"). NTEC is the new owner and operator of the Spring Creek Coal Mine and the Antelope Coal Mine where the licensed devices are used.
