Subject: Application for Export License for shipment of Nuclear Materials
to West Germany.

Dear Mr. Oplinger:

General Atomic has an immediate need for an export license to ship a fuel element containing 39 grams of Uranium 235 in approximately 196 grams of Uranium enriched in U-235 isotope to a nominal 19.9 percent to Munich, West Germany.

This element was originally shipped to West Germany March 27, 1978 under export license XSNM-1118, expiration date July 1, 1978. One of the elements in that shipment was subsequently damaged and imported on September 25, 1978 under License XSNM-78001 with expiration date of June 1, 1979. The contained fuel has been re clad and is to be reexported.

We request that you treat this as an application for a new license for this particular element or as an amendment to XSNM-1348 for which application was made on July 19, 1978 (Ref. IEL-947), and which is now under consideration by the Commission.

Your prompt attention to the issuance of an appropriate license or amendment to XSNM-1348 will be greatly appreciated.
