

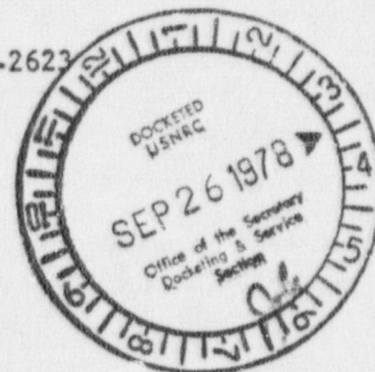

ADDENDUM TO SAFE ENERGY ALLIANCE PETITION FOR LEAVE  
TO INTERVENE

In its response dated September 12, 1978 to Safe Energy Alliance Petition to Intervene dated August 22, 1978, the NRC Staff states:

Although the NRC Staff does not oppose SEA's standing to intervene in this proceeding, its petition must be cured in one particular in order to fully comply with the interest requirements specified by 10 CFR §2.714. Specifically, SEA must establish its authorization to represent its members in this proceeding and it must identify the individual or individuals who are to represent the organization in this proceeding.

At a General Meeting of Safe Energy Alliance Members on September 14, 1978 a resolution was adopted in direct reply to NRC Staff's position on SEA's Petition to Intervene. The attached document captioned "AFFIDAVIT OF VIRGINIA BULLOCK" is a notarized report of the SEA resolution.

It is assumed that the affidavit serves to cure the defect in the Safe Energy Alliance Petition to Intervene.


