

Gentlemen:

In accordance with the requirements of the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Act, this is to inform you that NRC has not yet completed licensing action on your export application XSNM01015 to export low-enriched uranium fuel to Yugoslavia for the initial core loading of the Krsko reactor.

Executive Branch views on this application were received on August 2, 1978. In view of the complex nature of this export, particularly in regard to the disposition of the irradiated fuel, the NRC staff has had to perform a rather thorough review of this case. The staff analysis is now nearly complete and due to be forwarded to the Commissioners within a week for their decision.
