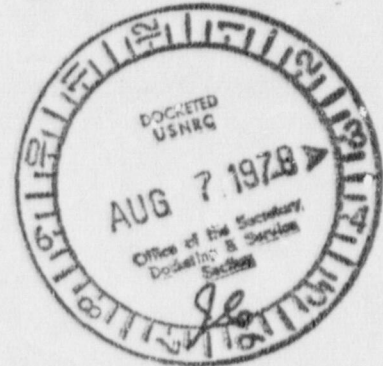

I wish to comment on the petition contained in the Feder Register and dated June 14, 1978. (Docket No. PRM-71-7, Non Destructive Testing Management Association, ET AL).

I have reviewed the requirements of the proposed change, Appendix E of Part 71, and I feel this change is unwarranted. I strongly believe that the Dot shipping requirements are sufficient and that this change will only increase cost, not to mention the tremendous amount of paper work that would be generated by manufacturer's users and the government agencies involved. I sincerely believe that the "minimal" safety does not warrant the overwhelming cost that will be incurred by all.
