Subject: Inspection 78-01

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. C. Stearns of this office on October 2, 1978 of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. 29-13850-01 and 29-13850-02 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Stearns with yourself at the conclusion of the inspection.

The areas examined during this inspection was limited to a final radiation and contamination survey of your former Whippany, New Jersey facility; to a review of the disposal of licensed material that had been possessed in that location; and to discussions with personnel concerning activities that had been conducted under your licenses. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. From the discussions at the conclusion of the inspection, it is our understanding that your licensed program is presently inactive and that you do not plan to use licensed materials in the near future. If our understanding differs from your intent, please notify us in writing to that effect.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
