This letter is in response to the violations as noted by Ms. S. Waldron on December 9, 1987.

In regards to Violation "A", McCallum Testing Laboratories, Inc. admits in failing to regular leak test every six months as required. We feel the tests were not completed as required because of inadequate record keeping. Since our inspection, we have leak tested every unit, set up individual files for each unit and we have assigned one individual to oversee this particular area of operation. We were in compliance as of December 17, 1987.

In regards to Violation "B" we again admit to the subject violation. It was an unfortunate oversight on our part. Since that inspection we have posted all required material on a bulletin board in a common area available to all employees. We were in compliance as of December 12, 1987.

We apologize for these violations and rest assured we will do everything in our power to see that we stay in compliance as required by our license.
