
It is requested that the Mount Sinai Medical Center NRC license be amended to reflect the following changes:

1. Authorize Ross A Abrams, M.D., to use Subpart G sources for brachytherapy. Dr. Abrams is licensed to practice medicine in the State of Wisconsin. He has recently passed the American Board of Radiology certification exams. Unfortunately no documentation is available to us at this time. Therefore, we request that you confirm Dr. Abrams' certification status to your own satisfaction with the American Board of Radiology.
2. Increase the possession limit for molybdenum 99/technetium 99m generators to 10.0 curies, which will include newly received generators, generators in service, and spent generators in storage. This is necessary in order to meet the needs for radiopharmaceuticals for increasing numbers of patient diagnoses. Generators shall be eluted and reagent kits shall be prepared in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
3. Authorize the possession of up to 225 pounds of depleted uranium as shields for generators. Shields from spent generators shall be returned to the generator manufacturer.
