
Enclosed are our applications to amend both our specific and general licenses 20-19842-01 and 20-19842-02G, to include the Oxford Analytical Instruments Lab-X 1000 series range of X-Ray Fluorescence devices.

The Lab-X 1000 range uses the same sources as currently licensed for use in our Lab-X 2000 series. The use of the devices remains unchanged. I have sent a detailed package to Steve Baggett, at the NRC in Washington, for the purpose of registration of the Lab-X 1000 range. I am enclosing one copy of this package with this letter for your own files.

I understand from our previous discussions that this simultaneous submission of applications should speed up the ultimate issue of amended licenses. Thank you for your assistance.
