SUMMARY

I called Mr. Blount to discuss the request for increasing the possession limit for I-125 (2nd increase in 1987). The letter states "current high demand for I-125 products labeled in our laboratory." The wording made me curious if they were manufacturing & distributing products (which is not authorized by current license). Mr. Blount said that ~90% of work involves receiving samples, tagging & analyzing samples in their lab. However, ~10% of work involves tagging specimens & returning to customers for a nominal fee. He had not considered the possibility of whether they needed a manufacturing &/or distributing license but requested time to look into it before processing amendment request.
