Dear Mr Baggett

You may recall our telephone conversation discussing the addition of the Oxford Analytical Instruments Lab-X 1000 range of X-ray fluourescence analysers to our range of registered devices.

I am now enclosing 2 copies of our application for a radiation safety evaluation and registration of the Lab-X 1000 range, together with the appropriate fee of \$580 for category 9A, as advised by Glenda Jackson of the NRC Fees Section.

You will notice from our application that the radioisotopes used in the Lab-X 1000 range, and the use of the devices, is identical to our current Lab-X 2000 range.

It is of the utmost importance to my company that we obtain the necessary registration, amended licenses and authorization to distribute, as soon as possible due to commercial and competitive factors. May I therefore request that we be advised of any foreseeable delays in the processing of this application, and of any steps which we can take in order to assist you in your review.

We formerly request that the detailed information contained in Section 2 and Section 3 of this application be held in confidence by NRC and be withheld from public disclosure. An affidavit is attached to this letter.
