SUBJECT: Amendment of NRC License

1. Request amendment to NRC License No. 12-16221-01 to include 10mCi CO-57 source for use by the USA-CERL Paint Laboratory in determining lead in paint.
2. Paragraph 10 requires additional sentence stating that the 10mCi CO-57 source will be used at USA-CERL and will also be used at U.S. military facilities in Germany. This equipment will be used under the supervision of the USA-CERL Radiological Protection Officer.
3. Paragraph 11 requires change to: Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of Michael R. Kemme, J. Lake Lattimore, Joseph E. Matherly, or Walter J. Mikucki.
4. As you requested, enclosed are the certificates of Radiological Training taken by the Radiological Protection Officer and his assistant.






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
