Jim -- I overlooked that I owed you a response to your e-mail. Having read the minutes, I would prefer not to release the OGC memo from me to Jordan unless really necessary or faced with a specific request, consistent with usual practice on OGC advice memoranda. The ultimate resolution of the issue is reflected in the letter -- and in that sense the letter speaks for itself. Having said that, I realize that due to my neglect, you may have proceeded otherwise, given our earlier conversation, and that does not give me big heartache!

Steve:

I did proceed with the release of the usual documents from CRGR files in connection with the Meeting No. 290 discussions, because I had begun to receive inquiries from outside the agency about CRGR review of the 50.54(f) letter involved; but I did NOT include the OGC-generated document in the documents sent to PDR. I took special care, in fact, in coordinating our release from CRGR files with EDOO, SECY and NRR (in addition to you). Enclosed for your information is the listing of documents we released to PDR.
