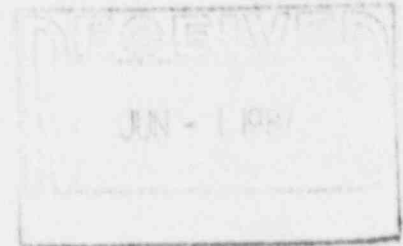

Dear Sir,

This letter is written in regard to license number 25-17163-02. June 1, 1985 the management structure of the Northern Rockies Regional Cancer Treatment Center (NRCC) was substantially changed. A new Board of Trustees was formed, composed of equal numbers of representatives from Deaconess Medical Center and Saint Vincent Hospital and Health Center. That Board is currently composed of the following members, with the Chairman noted: Lane Basso; John Bradford; Paul Crellin, M.D.; Lee Jockers; Bill Murray; Coy Rowland, Chairman and H.C. Habein, M.D., Ex-Officio. Membership in this Board is for a period of three years.

This change in the management structure with Douglas C. Carpenter, Jr. as Administrator, so far as we know, has never been reported to the NRC. We feel that the change is of sufficient magnitude to warrant reporting. No change in name or location of use has occurred. David W. Switzer, M.S., RSO reports to Mr. Carpenter.

The authorized users under our license are Fred A. Deigert, M.D. and James Trenholme Griffin, M.D. Included with this letter are the credentials of Fred Lindemann, M.D. Application is hereby made for license status for Dr. Lindemann. Ted O. Reinke, M.D. is no longer practicing with us. Please delete Dr. Reinke's name from our license.

Amendment number eight cites several letters of which we are in possession of the December 17, 1986 dated application and letter, the December 29, 1983 application (only), and the May 2, 1984 letter. Could you please copy your file documents and send them to us so that we may know the content of these documents. (Documents needed are those cited in Amendment 8, item 13, with the exceptions noted above.)

Very serious issues have confronted NRCC over the past few years. We are making progress in settling these issues. We look forward to demonstrating our ability to provide a good radiation safe environment. We would, also, like to express our appreciation for the professionally correct manner exhibited by your inspector, Mr. Wilburn on his inspection visit here.
