Subject: Inspection No. 87-001

On December 15 and 16, 1987, January 29 and February 3, 1988, Mrs. Teresa Hall Darden of this office conducted a routine safety inspection at the above address of activities authorized by the above listed NRC licenses. The inspection was an examination of your licensed activities as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's regulations and the license conditions. The inspection consisted of observations by the inspector, interviews with personnel, and a selective examination of representative records. The findings of the inspection were discussed with you and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection. A copy of the NRC inspection report is enclosed. This also refers to the telephone conversation on February 24, 1988 between you and your consultant, E. Port, and Mr. John D. Kinneman of this office.

As discussed during the telephone conversation on February 24, 1988 between yourself and Mr. Kinneman, the apparent violations identified during this inspection will be discussed at an Enforcement Conference at our office in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania at 1:30 p.m., March 4, 1988. We understand that you will attend this meeting with members of your staff. You should be prepared to discuss the causes of these apparent violations and your proposed corrective action. In addition to the violations, we are concerned that your release of iodine-125 to the environment is a large fraction of the applicable limit; you should be prepared to discuss your efforts to reduce these discharges. We would also like to discuss your efforts to assure that licensed material is secured against unauthorized removal. Enforcement action for these violations will be considered by the NRC following the Conference. The NRC Enforcement Policy is described in Appendix C of 10 CFR Part 2, a copy of which is enclosed for your information.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a) a copy of this letter and the enclosed report will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.




